- **IMPORTANT:** CU will be unable to process your application in a timely manner if you fail to **complete the form in full**. Forms with incomplete information will be returned to you for completion, delaying your application and registration.
- Registration is subject to **course availability**; the earlier you apply and register, the better your chances for space in your preferred classes with the exception of LING7800-050: "Linguistic Field Methods" and LING7800-017: "Field Methods and Endangered Languages". These courses have controlled enrollment in order to ensure the effectiveness of the class. - If you wish to receive **transfer credit** for Institute courses, please check with your home institution before registering. Provide your advisor with a course description and Institute description.
- Applications will be accepted until **June 1, 2011**. Anyone wishing to register after June 1, please email LSA2011@colorado.edu.
- Students and Affiliates are expected to **register for four one-credit hour LSA classes**.
- **Affiliates register for No Credit in four one-credit hour LSA classes**. The process is the same except No Credit is indicated. Please officially drop or add any courses even though your classes are No Credit because of spacing and tracking issues.
- **Registration** in the LSA Institute courses is a **three-step process**:
 1. First complete this Application form and provide your registration cost and selected fees payment. Submit the Application to LSAApp@colorado.edu. **NOTE:** If you are a **CU student** please take this completed form to the Continuing Education Office (1505 University Ave, the white building behind Macky).
 2. You will receive an email "Invitation to Register", including instructions for creating an IdentiKey account. Your IdentiKey allows you to activate "MyCUinfo" which enables you to request your preferred courses, as well as drop or add classes through July 8, 2011. Note: You can again drop and add between July 9 and July 13, but you must go to the Continuing Education building to do so. The IdentiKey also provides access to CU-Boulder wireless networks and various other CU systems.  3. You will receive a confirmation of your registration by email.
